

Analysis of Students' Feedback on Teachers

Academic Year: 2021-2022

Objective

To understand teachers' performance as perceived by the students.

Survey Method

The IQAC committee collected feedback on teachers from the college students through questionnaire in the month of May 2022. The feedback was collected offline due to the reduced severity of Covid-19 pandemic. There were 10 questions in the feedback questionnaire. The hardcopies of the questionnaire were provided to the students to fill them manually. They were asked to choose the appropriate out of 5 responses of all the questions.. These feedback forms were analysed on the basis of which necessary actions were taken to improve teachers overall performance.

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Results of analysis

1. Teachers performance mostly Outstanding and Very Good,
2. The respondents appreciated ability of the faculty to conduct mixed online-offline instruction method.
3. The respondents expected recruitment of more full time teachers.
4. The respondents expected from teachers to provide them with more online / offline study resources for self study.

In essence, the analysis indicate that students are satisfied with teachers' performance.

Objective

To understand views and expectations of the students about various courses in the college.

Method of Feedback Collection

The IQAC committee collected feedback on courses taught in the college from the students of FY, SY and TYBA classes through questionnaire in the month of May 2022 after the completion of the syllabus.. The hardcopies of the feedback questionnaire were provided to the students to fill them manually. The data were analysed manually.

There were 10 questions in the feedback questionnaire on the parameters as shown in the following table. The target average rating score for this feedback was 3.6 out of 4


The students' responses in this feedback were considered for the academic planning of the college activities during the academic year 2022-2023.



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Results of Analysis

The above table of analysis of the students' feedback on the College Services / Facilities indicate that

1. Majority of the respondents (94%) appeared to be satisfied with the curriculum delivery process and evaluation mechanism in the college.
2. The parameter 'Office student counters' received 100% 'Outstanding' responses, which indicate friendly / informal interactions of non-teaching staff with students.
3. The parameters Internet / WiFi connectivity, sports / recreation, NSS / extra-curricular Activities and Seminars / Webinars / Workshops / Group Discussions were rated highly - above 90% outstanding responses.
4. None of the parameter received 'Below Average' ratings.
5. The students suggested to improve library resources, separate playground for sport activities and to start career-oriented certificate courses.

In essence, the students appeared to be satisfied with services and facilities of the college.

The objective of this feedback was to understand experience, views and expectations of the ex-students of the college about the college activities. These feedback forms were analysed.



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
Results of Analysis:

The above table of analysis of the ex-students' feedback on curriculum indicate that:

1. All of the respondents (100%) feel proud to be associated with the college as an alumnus.
2. Most of them (above 90%) expressed their views that the college has played a key role in shaping their lives, and also opined that they get all that were they due as a student during their studentship days, and also that they would like to contribute to the growth of the college.
3. Majority (more than 90%) of the respondents appeared to be satisfied with the quality of education imparted in the college, evaluation mechanism, innovative teaching-learning methods and teachers' contribution to their professional growth.
4. Majority of the ex-students (90% or above) appeared to be satisfied with various academic initiatives taken by the college to improve students' competence like seminars / webinars Workshops / Group Discussions, educational tours and field visits.
5. The respondents suggested to improve the infrastructure of the institution and library resources.

In essence, the ex-students appeared to be satisfied with curricular and co-curricular activities of the college.




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Analysis of Parents' Feedback

Results of Analysis

1. All the parents (100%) appeared to be satisfied with the quality of the teachers and the examination system adopted by the college.
2. The parents appeared to be highly satisfied also with discipline maintained by the college, student's counselling and guidance, extra-curricular activities, WiFi facility, and Parent-teacher interaction.
3. None of the parameter received 'Average' and 'Below Average' rating
4. The parents appeared to be highly satisfied with the college activities and they expected separate building for the college.

It is also notable that the reported better overall performance of the college activities than it was during the previous four year.



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
