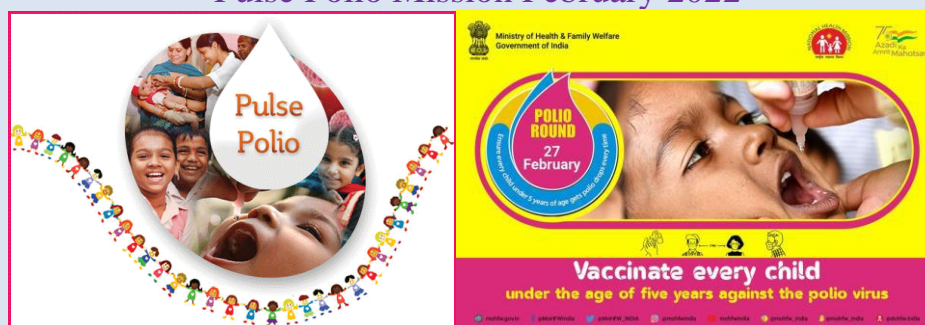


Event Report

Theme	Pulse Polio Mission: Two drops of Life (Do Bund Zindagi Ki)
Date	27 th February 2022
Sponsored by	Rural Hospital Visarwadi Tal Navapur
Purpose	To reach children in remote areas through improved social mobilization plan in order to make India Polio free.
Objective	The pulse Polio Immunisation (PPI) aims at covering every individual in India. With this aim state health department and Rural Hospital Visarwadi aspire to reach every children of rural and remote communities through an improved social commitment made by N. S. S. volunteers.
Organized by	Rural Hospital, Anganwadis and N. S. S. unit
Beneficiaries	Children of less than five years around Visarwadi
Highlights	Rural Hospital Visarwadi medical officer formed PPI centers at public places such as Anganwadis, Bus stands, temples where people often visits. The N. S. S. volunteers were divided into sex teams in order to assist health care service providers for the smooth conduct of the Pulse Polio Mission and its accomplishment.
Outcome	The pulse polio initiative took place with an objective of achieving one hundred percent coverage. Two drops of life to every child up to five years of age mission has brought polio virus down. The present drive has created high impact on the community where parents willingly take their child to the center for polio oral vaccine.
