Mumbai have many key takeaways, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Environmental awareness: NSS volunteers learn about their environment, ecosystems, and how to preserve the environment • Sense of purpose: volunteers feel a sense of ownership and purpose, and that their efforts make a difference • Teamwork: Students work together to plant trees, which helps them develop teamwork skills • Responsibility: Students learn responsibility by caring for the trees they plant • Leadership: Students develop leadership skills • Self-confidence: Students develop self-confidence • Observation: Students develop observation skills by watching how plants, animals, soil, and weather interact • Biodiversity: Trees help maintain biodiversity • Water conservation: Trees help conserve water • Global warming: Trees help reduce carbon emissions and global warming <p>Meanwhile volunteers also expressed thoughts that trees provide oxygen that they breathe. Trees reduce the amount of storm water runoff, which reduces erosion and pollution in our waterways and may reduce the effects of flooding. Many species of wildlife depend on trees for habitat.</p>
